- ✓ an article (Ivanov A.A.\_article), formatted in accordance with the requirements;
- ✓ a certificate of verification in the Antiplagiat system;
- ✓ an expert opinion.

## Requirements for formatting conference materials (RSCI)

**!!!! Materials submitted for publication will be considered only after online registration and payment for publication.**

The conference proceedings will be presented in an open access format, identified by ISBN, and posted in the National Bibliographic Database of Scientific Citations (RSCI).

A plagiarism check certificate (originality of at least 65%) and an expert opinion must be submitted as a separate file for each article.

Articles are accepted in Russian or English.

No more than two articles per author are allowed.

The conference proceedings will be printed in black and white.

The article should be between 3 and 10 pages long. File in MS Word format (\*.doc, \*.docx extension). Page size: A4 (210×297 mm). Margins: 2 cm on all sides. Line spacing: 1.5. Font: Times New Roman, 14 pt. Page numbers are not included.

### **Publication structure:**

- UDC (uppercase, left-aligned).
- **Article title** (lowercase, bold, centered).
- Blank line.
- *Author(s)' surname* (italics, lowercase, right-aligned).
- *Author(s)' place of work/study* (italics, lowercase, right-aligned).
- Blank line.
- [Surname and initials of the author(s), and article title] **duplicated in English** ([lowercase font],

centered).

- Blank line.

- ABSTRACT: (in Russian, uppercase font, justified alignment, paragraph – 1.25 cm).

- KEYWORDS: (in Russian, uppercase font, justified alignment, paragraph – 1.25 cm).

- ABSTRACT. (duplicated in English).

- KEYWORDS: (duplicated in English).

- Blank line.

- Main text (justified, paragraph - 1.25 cm). **Automatic hyphenation is prohibited. When typing, press Enter to move to the next paragraph. Tab and multiple spaces are not allowed to move to the next paragraph.**

- When typing numbers presented as decimal fractions, the integer part should be separated from the fractional part (or zero) by a comma, not a period (e.g., 23.6 or 100.0).

- A space should be left between the number and the percent sign (%) (e.g., 15.3%).

- The Latin names of genera and species of organisms are italicized.

- Materials may contain formulas in the standard Word formula editor.

- Tables, outline drawings and diagrams (black and white), and photographs are allowed.

Table captions are placed before the table. Figure and diagram captions are placed below them.

All tables, figures, and diagrams must be numbered and have a title.

**Do not use automatic numbering for tables, figures, or diagrams.**

- References (heading – lowercase, centered; list – lowercase, justified, paragraph – 1.25 cm).

- The list is ranked in the order of sources cited and is placed at the end of the article; descriptions in the list are compiled in accordance with GOST R 7.0.100-2018.

- References to primary sources in the text are enclosed in square brackets and include the reference number.

All articles are reviewed by experts in the relevant field of science and discussed at a meeting of the editorial board, which has the authority to recommend them for publication.

The publisher, members of the editorial board, and reviewers are not responsible for the content of the published article or for the consequences of its publication.

Articles that violate publication ethics and publication requirements will not be accepted for publication.




Figure 1 – Electrostatic field strength vectors of two atoms
