ics; Regular and Chaotic Dynamics; Soliton theory and its Applications; Algebraic and Geometric Methods; Mathematical Methods in Information Systems.

The conference languages are: **English, Russian.**

At the same time with the conference the scientific school “**Nonlinear days**” will take place. The aim of this school is to prepare students, postgraduates and early career researchers and get them familiar with materials related to the conference topics. We kindly ask the senior conference participants to encourage young scientists to participate. Some **funding may be available** for participants up to **35** years of age.
